A LETTER OF COLUMBUS.

W. S. Zimmerman, Circuit Court clerk of Citrus county Florida, and an archaeologist of note, has just reached Atlanta from San Carlos Bay Islands, south of Fort Meyers, where with a number of friends he has been on a camp hunt. On one of the islands Zimmerman and his friends found the remains of a Spanish expedition sent out from Cuba by Christopher Columbus, when the great discoverer was governor of the island. While hunting the men passed a low mound, and at Zimmerman's request an investigation was made. After a little digging something hard was struck, and when unearthed, it was found to be a complete suit of armor. Zimmerman pried open the helmet of one of the suits and was shocked to see a skull. The entire suit was then opened and found to contain a skeleton. The other suits were opened and also found to contain skeletons. Excavations made in Toledo were found near the skeletons. Further digging brought to light an iron box of Spanish doubloons, worth \$6000, a few blunderbusses and culasses of antique pattern, bearing the name Sebastian Velazquez and the date 1492. Zimmerman is inclined to dig and was rewarded by unearthing another box which proved the most interesting find of all. In this box were found a portrait of a beautiful woman painted on ivory, a medalion dates 1497, on which was a raised figure of Christopher Columbus and a roll of parchment covered with writing. Zimmerman, who is a linguist, soon saw that the parchment was a letter from Columbus to Sebastian Velazquez, and related to an expedition which the latter was to lead from Cuba to explore the coasts of Florida. The letter was one of instruction, and was signed by Columbus as Governor of Cuba. The Atlanta Constitution further says that the doubloons will be divided among the members of the party, and the relics deposited to the government or to one of the universities.
