"All right. There's your repair kit. You can either put it in a paper of pins and some sticking plaster, or else give me back my money."
In business it is the little things that count. The loss of a small amount on a bill is itself a little thing, but the sum total of these little losses reach large sums. The giving of a fraction overweight is a small loss in itself, but the daily transactions of the store are numerous and the little overweight soon makes a big loss. The loss of a single customer, is perhaps, viewed as a single loss, unimportant, but the influence of the lost customer counted against the store will cause the loss of other customers. The failure to deliver an order at the time specified is a little thing, but the customer's pain may have been slight by the delay, and a seed of dissatisfaction sown that may result in the loss of a customer. The failure to fill an order correctly or the omission of a single article may be a little thing, but the unsatisfied article may have been the most needed and an angry customer is the result. Little losses and little errors should be avoided.—Grocers' Review.
