HINTS TO HOUSEKEEPERS.

Ginger Soaps .- One onp of molasses, one half cup of butter or shortening bested and put in the molasses, one quarter out of water, one tempoonfut of sode, one and a half teaspoonsful of giuger. Flour enough to roll rather soft. Bake in a quigh oven. Soft Ginger Cakes .- One pint of molassee, one cup of lard, one cup ot water, one teaspoonful of saleratus, one tablespoonful of salt, one tablespoonful of ginger. Allow flour enough to roll soft as possible, and bake quickly, but not with a very hot

fire, as they burn easily. Fried Cutlets of fish .- Cut any kind of fresh fish in billets; have all the same size and shape, sprinkle with pepper and .salt, dip in egg batter and fry in boiling lard. Arrange in a circle on a dish, and garnish with fried paraley and slices of lemon.

Fish sauce.-Chop fine six hard-bolled eggs and stir in two cups of drawn butter. Lot simmer and add, one taklespoonful of pepper sauce, two of minced parsley with a little thyme and salt. Pour over boiled

Pick cold bite of feh in pieces, put in a sancepan with two table spoonsful of flour and butter cach ; mix well and add a plot of boiling water. Have ready hot elices of buttered toast, pour the fish over and serve. Baked White Fish .- Scale and remove all the fins and bead, then clean thorough-Wash and wipe it and salt it well inside. 


