**NOTES AND COMMENTS.**

At Napanee the other day a man was awarded \$7000 damages at the Assizes for the fracture of a leg, caused by getting entangled in a defective plank walk. At the Kent assizes the same week, a resident of Chatham relieved the corporation of that city of \$400 for injuries sustained by a fall due to a rotten plank.

According to a return just brought down, 82,250,000 Jubilee stamps and 7,000,000 one-cent Jubilee post-cards were issued by the Government, the cost of factoring being \$19,000. Of the present issue of stamp, which were placed on sale in November, 1897, 312,320,000 were printed, and 30,500,000 post-cards.

By general order dated 1st December, 1898, the sale of intoxicating liquors in regimental messes and canteens at camps of instruction was entirely prohibited. This order is still in force, and the Minister of Militia has caused orders to be issued that henceforth the general order above mentioned is to be followed in its entirety.

A number of Public School Boards throughout the Province have petitioned the Department of Education to be relieved of the burden of a Collegiate Institute, on the ground that it is a hindrance to good work in the Public Schools. It is suggested that there be fewer Collegiates and High Schools, better equipped, and that the pupils be charged a fee.

The Boston Manufacturers' Mutual Fire Insurance Company, in response to many inquiries from its members, has had the subject of asylums, lighting, including its advantages and dangers, and the proper application to use, for the purpose, carefully examined, and, as a result of its examination, action is imminent not to try the experiment of using it at present, until better methods and appliances are available than any yet put on the market.

The Scottish Farmer, a paper of national reputation, is devoting considerable space to Canadian topics. In a recent issue it gave a condensed resume of Manitoba's agricultural production and wealth, with comprehensive statistics relating to the development of the Province. The article is prefaced with the statement that "already this year nearly 800 farmers, farm servants and others with families have left Scotland to try their fortunes amongst the soil and sun in the Dominion."

The Manitoba Farmers who have best cattle will this spring will reap a harvest, as prices are very high, as much as five and half cents a pound being paid on the Yards. An enormous trade has been done for several months past in stockers, the province having been secured by buyers from the States and the North-West Territories, who have paid from \$12 to \$18 for yearlings. A prominent rancher says that the Territorial ranchers can take all the stockers that the Manitoba farmers can raise, and urges that they should pay particular attention to this branch of business.

Among the amendments of the Municipal Act during the last session of the Legislative Assembly of Ontario, of which little mention has thus far been made in the public press, is one providing that newspaper publishers, who are members of municipal councils or public school boards, are not thereby relieved from inserting "advertisements, economy public notices and statements" payment thereof. The amendment is intended to remedy a very anomalous condition of affairs, and to apply to municipal corporations an exception in favor of journalists, the principal of which has already been embodied in the Provincial Electoral Act.
