EVERLASTING.

"It will no doubt surprise many of our eaders to be told here that among the .iuventors of "freaks" appears the name of the distinguished President, Abraham Lincoln. But it was long before he over dreamed that he would one day give a million human beings their freedom by a single stroke of his pen. The freak invention of Lincoln was an "unsinkable steamship" which was never considered feasible enough even for a practicable trial. It was patented in 1849, and consisted of au ordinary steamship with rubber airbags attached to the sides. 


