MORE CANADIAN SOLDIERS.
The war in South Africa has caused unprecedented anxiety throughout the empire during the past week. Serious engagements were fought by the forces of General Buller at Colenso and by General Methuen at Mafeking, but both were repulsed with terrible loss, and obliged to retire to former positions. As a result, the British Government has been forced to increase its contribution to the war in South Africa. General Lord Roberts has been given command of the entire forces, with General Lord Kitchener as Chief of Staff. General Buller will command all the forces in Natal.
