EDITORIAL NOTES.

A statement issued by the Finance Minister shows that for the seven months ending Jan. 31st, the revenue had increased \$10,167,428. Not there was an increase of expenditure during the same period of \$1,045,422. The capital expenditure of the same time was \$60,000 less than the previous year.

The question of the establishment of a market for "Austen" is not to be allowed to drop. The interesting letter from "Oliver" in this issue, pointing out some of the advantages to be had with the interest will be read with interest by farmers and citizens. At a banquet to Premier Macdonald at Emerson, Man., last Friday night the Premier, in referring to the railway bonuses voted by the Greenway Government, said: "The present Government had decided to refuse to pay the bonuses, but the railway companies justified it so well. They had laid down as our plank in their platform Government ownership of railways, and no bonuses to be granted unless certain concessions are obtained."

The Prohibitionists will ask the Ontario Government to have a referendum on the more stringent laws. One amendment to be asked will be reduction of the fine imposed on men found drinking in unlicensed places, as the present fine is not high; those convicted will not give evidence, and therefore convictions of drunks are very difficult. Hotel-keepers will support this change. It will also be asked that alleged temperance hotels be placed under inspection. Another change sought is to make the tenure of a license yearly, thereby compelling the annual petition of the hotel keeper.

At a meeting of the Imperial Utility League at Ottawa on Monday evening the council in its report recommended for consideration a draft of an Imperial consolidation bill, making provision for the entry of all colonies and dependencies into the new political organization, when they think fit, at the same time making no alteration in the present status of each colony. It did not however use legislative body attached to those now in existence, but would reconstruct the present House of Lords so as to give representation to both the outer Empire and United Kingdom. The measure will also favor the introduction of international free trade, while relying on Customs duties on foreign materials to provide for national defense.

The annual report of Action Free Library shows that the library now has 172 readers. During the past year the readers, who are young folk, for the most part, read 3267 volumes. This includes much of the very best literature, and the oft-expressed statement that more works of fiction are issued from public libraries than all other classes combined is not borne out by the records of the Action Free Library. Of the books issued just one-third were fiction.
