An ideal Christian daily newspaper is to be published by Rev. Charles M. Sheldon, author of "In His Steps," next week. Beginning on Tuesday, the first, it will add the Toledo Daily Capital, one of the titles published in his own city, and will apply to every detail of its editorial work the question presented in his famous book: "What would Jesus Do?" His endeavor will be to run the newspaper entrusted to him not as an endeavor to follow Jesus, but as a business venture. He has suggested that he is quite willing to give the time necessary to all their men in order to deliver a newspaper in several languages. His unique experiment in daily journalism will be watched with great interest.

Canada well deserves the praise which Lord Roberts and the press and people of the empire are showering upon her. Our brave Canadian soldiers nobly won their spurs, and many of them, also, have shed their life's blood in defense of the glorious cause of freedom and right in South Africa.

These deeds of patriotism, which have been acknowledged without the slightest shade of grudging by the commander-in-chief of the forces in South Africa, tend politically to widen up our horizon, the gathering clouds of war, and the local soldier into one grand whole in an ideal empire, which shall stand to all time for civilization, progress, and the highest type of human freedom.

His recently published sketch "The Boer War: Its Causes and Its Interest to Canadians," Mr. E. B. Biggar, the writer, says: "What will be the outcome of the war? In all probability the end of the present colonies and states in Canada, but, if possible, a prince or two, in the case of Canada; but, if otherwise, for detailed

When the British and Dutch have got together, after the present conflict, they will meet, by a study of their past history, that the policy of mutual hate, distrust, and intolerance is a policy that must break their land with ruin; but the policy of good-will among the white race will make South Africa what it climate and latent resources fit it to become—one of the most delightful in the world. This much is certain, that in the settlement to be made the British Government will not reward upon the Boers the injustice under which the Unfriendly population has groaned for the past eighteen years."

THE BOERS ARE ABANDONING STRONG POSITIONS

In Cape Colony and Have Retreated Entirely from Natal, Leaving Ambulances with Sick and Wounded.

GEN. ROBERTS PREPARING FOR A CRUSHING BLOW IN A FEW DAYS.

London, March 7.—The people are still reflecting over the great victories of last week in the forced surrenders of Groote and the relief of Ladysmith. The British press is still giving credit to the Canadians for their brilliant work. After advising the continuance of the work preparation of the troops continued. The Times concluded: "The British General has brought down a detailed statement of the cost of the two contingents to South Africa. The total amount estimated is \$1,000,000, but the General is taking out costs for the recent ten millions in order to provide for unforeseen claims.

The day has well in £100,000 for the first contingent, £100,000 for the Canadian Mounted Rifles, and £20,000 for the Royal Canadian Artillery. These were transported to Port Elizabeth on the 21st, and transportation to Port Elizabeth cost £100,000.

Transport by sea cost £37,000, and friends spent the day's pleasure with the old lady.
