The heavy advance in the price of paper and the imposition of newspaper postage have caused a number of weekly papers to adopt the Pass Paper plan of publishing for sale only.

The chief colonization agent of the C. P. R. in the district of Alberta and other sections of New Ontario, is bearing a government commission to the French West Indies, and is looking over the district in view of the government's intention of opening up of that district for settlement.

The society of paper, due to the burning of the Eddy paper mills and the Lorington mills has appealed to members of Parliament, and action is being taken in the House of Commons to induce the Government to temporarily remove printing paper from the dutiable list.
