## The Pan-American Exposition—To be Held at Buffalo, 1901.

Beautiful Buildings and Picturesque Grounds in Course of Construction Since Last September.

In the external features of the Pan-American Exposition, to be held at Buffalo, 1901, the primary object of which is to illustrate the material progress of the New World during the nineteenth century, many prominent elements of civility will be introduced. One of the most important of these will be the admirable character, grouping, and minor schemes of the buildings in association with the extent of the grounds, which will be marked by horticultural and architectural displays of the most ambitious character.

The attractiveness of the buildings and grounds at night will be vastly enhanced by the extent, brilliancy and novelty of the electrical illuminations, which will be ever present. Results not possible in this direction at the World's Fair of Chicago, will be attained, and it is not likely that anything like the marvellous electrical illumination scheme planned for

The entrance to the tower is across an ornamental bridge from the plaza, on the north side. Elevators will carry passengers to the various floors, which will be devoted to different purposes of the Exposition, such as reception, promenade, restaurant, boulevard and amusement hall. A large restaurant, at a height of two hundred feet, will give the diner a broad and beautiful view of the Exposition and the surrounding landscape. From the cupola the eye sweeps the wide Niagara frontier, and look far into Canada, beyond the majestic river that separates that country from the States.

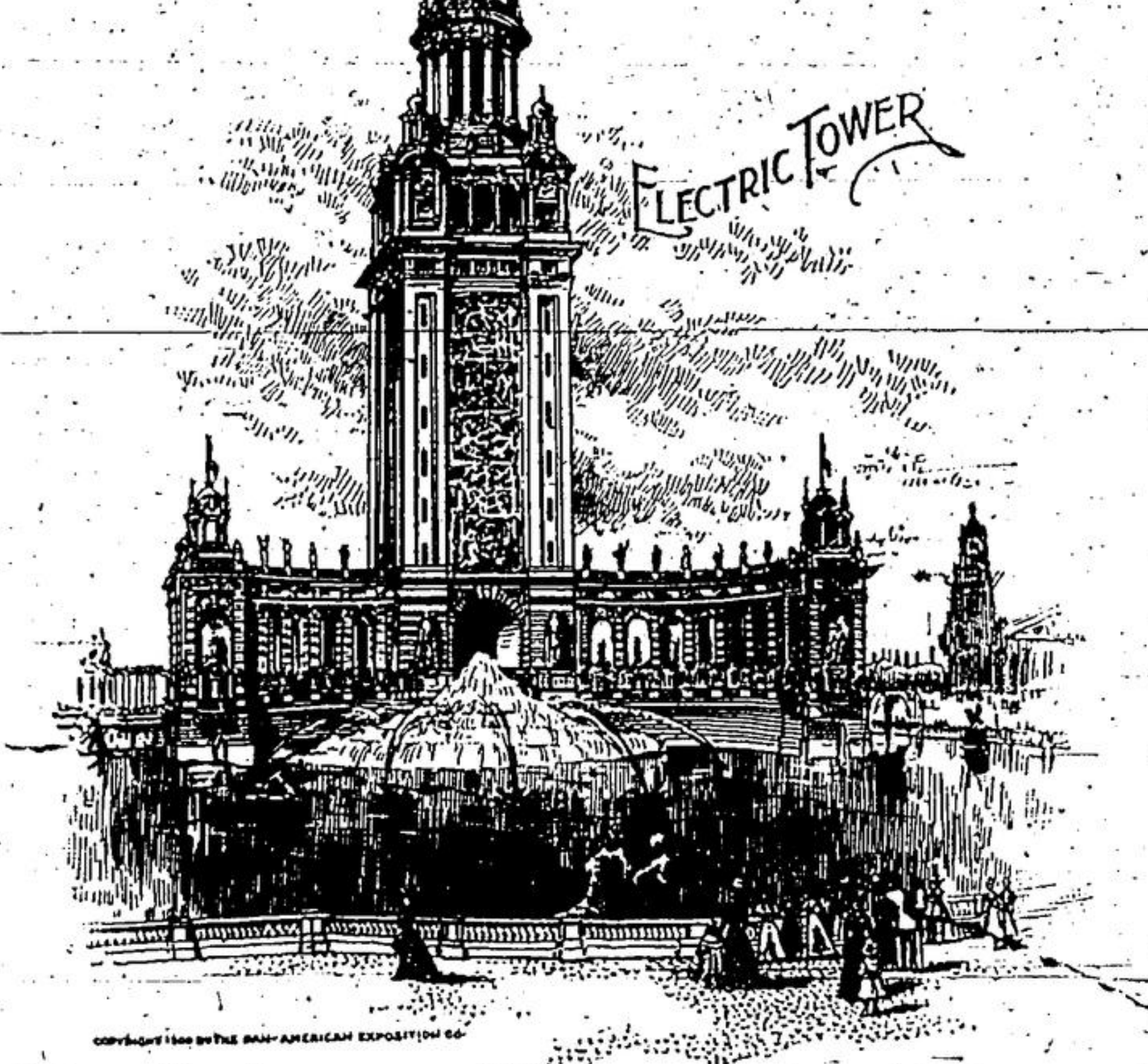


ILLUSTRATION BY THE PAN-AMERICAN EXPOSITION CO.

Buffalo in 1901 will be approached in Paris this year. It has been determined to make this scheme at the Pan-American Exposition a triumph of electrical achievement, as marvellous to the public and as important to science as the harnessing of the forces of the Niagara river, and the transmission to Buffalo last year, will command the rapid admiration of every visitor. The genius of the architect has been taxed to preserve lines and elements of beauty in a work of such tall proportions, but the problem has been well mastered.

The height of the tower is 311 feet above the broad basin in which it stands. Its position is between the Court of the Fontaines and the Plaza, on the north side of the Mall. It looks down upon the Agricultural Building at the west and the Electric Building on the east and west by long curving colonnades, which sweep to the southeast and terminate in a fine pavilion, forming a semi-circular space two hundred feet across. Within this space and in a high niche in the middle of the tower are cascades, which will be the basis for the fountain and water play. The tower is a brilliant water scene. At the centre of the niche is a tall geyser fountain, whose waters find their way from the high basin within the niche over successive ledges and among a multifarious set of pipes to the level of the pool. The main body of the tower is slightly fluted. From the surface of the water to the top of the colonnade is seventy-five feet. This portion of the structure is enclosed by a system of spiral walkways. The shaft of the tower is treated with great simplicity. The centre of each side is paneled with functionally perforated work, through which is indistinctly revealed the massive frame work of the tower. This feature is calculated to produce a remarkable effect when lighted from within. The main shaft of the tower terminates in an elaborate and composed of three stories of diminishing proportions and varying design. The lower of these stories is an arched loggia, rich in ornamentation and having the wall surface brilliant and glowing. Pavilions at the corners terminate in high fantastic cupolas. The second stage, or lantern of the tower crown, is in the form of a high, slender colonnade, entirely open, so as to allow the effect of

the sky to be seen between the columns. A spiral staircase within the colonnade leads to the last stage of the tower, the people, perched upon the dome, is the supreme glory of Electricity herself, thus dominating the entire Exposition, which owes so much to her generosity and power.
