### TO CARE FOR A WATCH.

A well-known watchmaker says that if people only followed the directions given below, they would have very little trouble with their watches.  
Wind the watch in the morning and not at night, as directly after winding it works best, and can thus better stand the constant movement of the wearer during the day.

Clean the pocket in which it is kept frequently, or that is certain to get into it.
