

INCREASED TO \$500 A YEAR

The Committee on Finance presented its report and recommended that the salary of the Municipal Officer be increased from \$300 to \$500 per annum, to take effect on April 1st, 1922.

Counsellor Swackhammer opposed the increase, stating that the present salary was adequate and that the proposed increase was unnecessary. He stated that the Municipal Officer's duties were not commensurate with the proposed increase and that the increase would result in a loss of funds to the City.

The Council, after a long deliberation, voted to accept the increase in salary of the Municipal Officer from \$300 to \$500 per annum, to take effect on April 1st, 1922.
