THE SILVER DOLLAR.

This new strain is the most popular general crop potato in the Maritime Provinces.

It is an immense yielder and is a round white potato with some what deep pink eyes. It is a very early potato, ripening in the first week of August.

We imported one large car, 455 bags, in November just before the cold weather and they have never seen the frost.

We propose to sell them out as long as they last at \$1.25 per bag of 50 lbs; and more than 10 bags to any one person, as we wish to distribute the seed and give everybody an opportunity of getting this great potato.

Purchasers not wishing to remove them at once, may, by depositing 25¢ per bag on them, leave them with us for a few weeks. This is a good opportunity to get a few hundred potatoes at a very reasonable price.
