Expire Next Month and Council is Requested to make a Final Assessment.

A communication was received from the Municipal Council of St. Mary's asking Acton Council to endorse their petition to the Provincial Legislature to enact legislation requiring that the vehicles of vehicles designed to carry over one ton or over on the public roadways of the Province shall have three at least five inch wheels.

At this point Mr. Beardmore addressed the Council. He explained that the partial exemption, which the Council had favored them with in recognition of their services as long-time employers of labor, would expire on May 24th, 1924, and requested that the action the Council now proposed to take in relation to their earliest consideration of the matter.

Mr. Beardmore stated that the location of Acton so far remote from the source of supply of the headlock bark, which the tannery uses in such large quantities, was a serious charge on the profits of the business. The cost is increasing every year, and as they export about forty per cent. of the sole leather they manufacture, they found it difficult to compete with the tanneries located in the bark country and with the United States Leather Co., which has its own bark lands.
