COUNCIL HONORS GO A-BEGGING

Action Has Only A Reeve and Two
Committees Left.

COPIES OF THE BRIDGE UNKNOWN

The non-mitting day has come and gone, and, as the Fire Powers predicted several weeks ago, seats at the Council bench have gone a-begging. Four candidates were put up for the Vice-chairman and chairman for Councillors. At nine o'clock on New Year's night it was found that Reeve Swackhamer had been elected by acclamation, and that only three of the candidates for Council had put in their nominations. Dr. Gray, Alex Bell and N. W. Hirst, the latter is dis-qualified owing to the fact that he is assistant engineer of the Fire Company, and therefore a paid servant of the Corporation and ineligible for the position.

The Council meeting today is therefore: Reeve—H. Swackhamer; Chairman of the Committee on Streets & Walks, Mr. Bell; Vice-chairman, Mr. Hirst; and the three remaining members of the Council.

The local option by law of Owen Sound applies the appeal of Mr. Sinclair having been denied by the court. This was the third or fourth effort to quash the by-law. Hydroelectricity evidently profits in Owen Sound.

Amongst the candidates for the proposed Councilor of Waterloo, supporting Councilor William McDonald, was a local boy, Mr. John Clark, who will receive liberal support in the part of the township. George Wetherby has been brought out again. He has proved himself a useful man in past years. Councilor Thomas Cook is another popular candidate from this vicinity.

Judging from the Christmas Day sermons the leading ministers of London, Eng., are fully alive to the bounds being made by the drink habit.
