A TRIBUTE TO THE ARMY TEMPERANCE MOVEMENT.

In the course of a speech at the opening of a Lecture Exhibition held recently in Exeter, English behalf of the Soldiers and Sailors Help Society, Lord Methuen, who presided, referred in suggestive terms to the good results from the temperance movement noted in the British Army of to-day. "Sir Hedley Buller will agree with me," he said, "that the soldier when he joined and the soldier of to-day are totally different. I do not mean to say for one moment that the soldier of to-day is greater in courage or finer in physique, because he is nothing of the sort; but the civilians have handed over to us an article which more amenable—a man who is freer from drink, a man who is much more subordinate. That is owing entirely to the temperance movement in this country." Lord Methuen said that without touching upon moment on politics, he thought it was the duty of the legislature of the country to such steps as they could to prevent children from entering publications houses.

These statements give yet another instance of the favor in which temperance work is held by eminent naval and military officers.


