The recent new postal arrangements
between Canada and the United States
will affect the payment of newspaper rates
of one cent per issue, four times a month,
thereby increasing the cost of the

in the United States. The future sub-

therefore, be \$1.50 per year. When \$1

EDITORIAL NOTES.

The Provincial Government will do
well to treat the New Ontario agitation
sympathetically, and to effect what
changes are within its power, with a
view to satisfying the people and ad-
ministering to their prosperity and

A careful study of the statements of
the Finance Department shows that
the result of the financial year, which
ended on March 31st, will be a sur-
plus on the consolidated fund of \$16,-
500,000, and a debt reduction of \$3,500,-
000. Canada is certainly prosperous.

The first prosecutions in Winnipeg
for violation of the new Lord's Day
Act occurred in the police court there
on Monday morning, when eighteen
retail restaurants were fined \$1 and
costs each for selling on Sunday mer-
chandise not consumed on the premises.
In most instances tobacco was the
article unlawfully dispensed.

The menace of bad rails in the
United States is increasing. Four
hundred and forty-nine rails, of which
a hundred and seventy-nine were new,
broke on one railway in the month of
February. One trip of a fast train on
one railway a few weeks ago broke
eighteen rails in five hundred miles.
In New York, eight hundred
dried and rotten trees struck the rail
break last year, while in 1901, before
the trust monopolized the business of
steel-rail making, only twenty-nine
defective rails were found on the same
tracks. The situation is most serious,
and calls for the immediate punishment
of those responsible. Unfortunately
Canada's railways are not without
guilt in the using of cheap
and dangerous rails.

Prof. MacNaughton, of McGill
University, Montreal, writing in the
June number of The Canadian Maga-
zine, introduces a subject that is bound
sooner or later to have a place in the
politics of the Dominion—the question of
woman suffrage. He goes into the
subject in a thorough, masterly way,
and he has spent some years in
Australia, where women exercise the
franchise, has first-hand knowledge
of how the proposal works out in practice.
Prof. MacNaughton is in favor of
giving women the right to vote, and
he asks that the public should give
such weight to his main contention is
that the vote of the head of a family is
generally a point of prudence, and that
if women could vote with men the
power of the family or prudential vote
would be enormously increased. The
Canadian Magazine, it is worth noting,

Adam roadway.

is to be maintained and our citi-
zens' comfort fairly considered.

500,000 CHURCH DESTROYED.

Church of the Sacred Heart at Ottawa
was burnt Saturday night.

Ottawa, June 11.—The Sacred Heart,
Ottawa, considered the most magnifi-
cent Catholic edifice in Ottawa city,
was totally destroyed by fire last evening,
leaving a total loss of \$100,000, with in-
surance of \$60,000.

The fire broke out shortly before six
o'clock from a cause apparently un-
known. There were no fires on the
building at the time, and the electric
current was turned off. The flames
originated in the main entrance, and
by some it is thought that boys smoke-
ing cigarettes in the main entrance
were responsible.

It was considered the church of the
high-class French-Canadians, and Sir
Wilfred Laurier, Hon. J. P. Drouard
and Hon. J. T. Tarte were among the
parishioners.
