SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOME ESTUAD REGULATIONS

As by order in council of the Dominion of Canada, in relation to the regulations for the settlement of the Northwest.

1. The homestead is a tract of land in the Northwest, not exceeding 160 acres in extent.

2. The homestead is to be settled by a person who is at least 18 years of age, and is a citizen of the Dominion of Canada.

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
