HOW TO PICKLE BEANS.

Take fresh stringless wax beans. To each quart of beans, after they have been cooked, add the juice of two large lemons, two handfuls tablespoonfuls of sugar, one over teaspoonful of salt and enough water to cover beans. Allow to stand twenty-four hours before using.

Green dry beans should always be cooked at a low temperature, and with very little water, or steamed. Steaming is to be preferred to any other method of preparing this nutritious vegetable.—From September Physical Culture.
