EDITORIAL NOTES

So far this year the Ontario Provincial Police, acting in conjunction with the Dominion Immigration authorities have arrested 257 undesirable citizens, mostly at Windsor and Nickel Falls. During the past few weeks there has been an unusually large number of deportations from Port Frances and Rainy River.

During the first half of the current year the mineral output of Ontario was valued at over twelve and one-half million dollars. The silver output was valued at six and one-quarter millions, nearly a million more than the corresponding period last year. The output of pig iron was valued at three and one-half millions, of nickel at over two millions and of copper at \$600,000.

Last year 1,205,000,000 passengers were handled on the British railways and only one was killed by an accident to a train. Nineteen, however, were killed in getting on or off trains and 500 were injured in the same way. The British railways seem to have reached perfection in the matter of safety. But our own are not to be regarded as wanting in care. Every year the degree of safety is raised.

In a speech delivered in Germany last week Emperor William reiterated his belief that he holds his crown not as the result of the consent of Parliament or People's Assemblies, but by Divine Right. He saw in himself, he said, "the chosen instrument of Heaven and as such he regards his duty as regent and ruler." The German press generally criticizes the Emperor's utterances, some going so far as to declare that the Kaiser is merely a constitutional monarch, while even some of the strongest supporters of the monarchy fear that the speech will have the effect of rousing antagonism to the whole monarchical principle. The organ of the landed nobility strongly approves the declaration made.

Council last in regular session on Tuesday evening, Monday being a public holiday, with the members all present. The Reeve in the chair.

The Reeve wanted to know if the master should be held over further.

Conrad Holt thought it should be decided one way or the other at once.

Gauvin McDonald said that if citizens had any objections to raise in regard to Council granting a license they had an opportunity, but none were forthcoming.

Then it came rather as a surprise to some when the clerk and solicitor informed the Council that they had not the power to prohibit persons starting a billiard and pool room, as that was a privilege anyone might have. The Council could only impose a license for such place as were opened, and, at that, the law prohibited the imposition of a billiard fee.

The Reeve remarked that he guessed that under the billiard business for the night, the Council would have a special meeting to decide on a proper fee and form rules and regulations regarding hours, size of patrons, etc.

And if the applicants for license opened a billiard and pool room they would have to abide by the Council's decision in the matter.

Mr. W. D. Beardmore addressed the Council regarding the billiard and pool room, and the solicitor and presented plans showing the route of same.
