EDITORIAL NOTES  
A bill has been introduced in the Legislature of New York providing that it shall be a misdemeanor to furnish cigars, cigarettes, tobacco or the making of the same to persons under the age of sixteen years.

The Ontario branch of the Dominion Alliance asked Sir James Whitney last Thursday to expunge the three-fifths clause from the local option law of this province and also to enact prohibitive legislation affecting the liquor traffic, as far as it was possible in Ontario. Both of these petitions were unconvincingly refused by the Premier. Hon. W. J. Hanna, who was in company with Sir James, vigorously defended the three-fifths clause as a force for temperance.

It is passing strange how the same classes of the community view the reciprocity agreement in the two countries. The Nashville, Tennessee, Advocate says: "The Patrons of Husbandry, a farmers' organization with a membership of 1,000,000, is making a fight against the reciprocity agreement with Canada. They claim that by the terms of the treaty the farmer is being discriminated against, inasmuch as every article that he buys is protected by a tariff, while he is obliged to compete with free trade prices on everything he has to sell. A committee has been appointed to oppose the agreement in Washington, and to arouse sentiment against it among the farmers all over the country."

**COUNTY ALLIANCE ORGANIZED**  
Temperance Workers Plan for Forward Steps at Convention on Monday  
MILTON MAY VOTE ON LOCAL OPTION  
A new organization, "The Halton County Temperance Alliance," was formed with a view to effecting further progress along temperance lines in the county, was brought into being at the convention held under the auspices of the Ontario Branch of the Dominion Alliance in Milton on Monday of this week.

Much enthusiasm was manifested among the representatives from almost every municipality, who gathered in the town hall at 2 p. m. After opening exercises an address was delivered by Rev. William Kettlewell, Field Secretary of the Alliance, outlining the purpose of county organization and the benefits to be derived therefrom.

After some discussion the following resolution was brought forward and carried unanimously:  
"That an organization be formed to be known as 'Halton County Temperance Alliance,' in affiliation with the Ontario Branch of the Dominion Alliance, with the object of uniting all the friends of temperance in the county of Halton in a practical effort to secure the greatest present support and speediest ultimate suppression of the liquor traffic for beverage purposes."

The officers of the Alliance shall consist of a President, four Vice-Presidents, a Secretary and Treasurer. The executive committee shall consist of the officers, together with four other persons.  
All ministers resident within the county or part of whose work lies within the county, shall be corresponding members of the executive committee.

The nominating committee's recommendation regarding officers was accepted, and the following will constitute the officers for the new organization:  
President—H. P. Moore, Acton; 1st Vice-Pres.—J. D. McGregor, Oakville; 2nd Vice-Pres.—W. J. L. Hampshire, South Block; 3rd Vice-Pres.—H. Crawford, Campbellville; 4th Vice-Pres.—E. H. Cleaver, Burlington; Secretary—J. L. Moore, Speybridge; Treasurer—G. H. Brown, Milton.

Four representatives in Executive Committee: Henry Hall, A. W. Newell, Milton; T. K. Reed, Georgetown; D. D. Christie, Dundas.  
The following were also appointed provisional convenors for the several municipalities to see that permanent organization is effected, those in the meantime to be members of the Executive Committee: Kettlewell, Wm. Cook, Ashgrove; Nassagaweya, B. Manzie, Campbellville; Trafalgar, L. Wrench, Milton; Nelson, R. W. G. Lowville, Acton; Rev. J. C. Wilson, B. A. Burlington, Wesley Freeman; Georgetown, Dr. W. E. Wattam; Milton, J. H. Peacock; Oakville, Rev. J. W. Magwood.

The evening session took the form of a public mass meeting, also held in the town hall, which was well attended by the representatives and Milton citizens. Addresses were given by Rev. J. Geo. Miller, Field Secretary, and Hon. Ben. H. Spence, General Secretary of the Dominion Alliance, outlining and explaining the Ontario local option law as the best means of meeting the present situation, and remedying the abuses which come from the licensed liquor traffic.

The speaker was given by Howard Russell, the young Toronto baritone. Considerable interest has been attracted in Milton, the only municipality in the county which has not yet voted on Local Option, as a result of the convention, and it is said that there is some prospect of a by-law being submitted to the county town next January.
