The first musical magazine started in Germany was founded in 1722. It was called Musica Critica, and was directed by Handel's rival, Mattheson. A vast number of musical papers followed this one, and at the present time in Germany there are over thirty musical magazines. The first musical paper of France and Germany was founded in 1726. The first English musical paper was founded in 1822. In 1742 the first musical paper was established in America. It was known as Andrew Lewis's Musical Magazine. The average musical Magazine is short-lived. There are two hundred and fifty American musical magazines on file at the Library of Congress. Most of these discontinued publications long ago. One of the most famous of musical magazines was Dwight's Journal of Music, which was published from 1822 to 1881, and maintained its existence until the publisher retired.—The Kinist.
