**EDITORIAL NOTES**

THE COMMISSIONERS at Niagara Falls have decided, in view of the fatalities last year, that no person will be allowed to walk on the ice bridge over the river hereafter.

A COMMITTEE of the Toronto Board of Trade has been studying the high cost of living, and for a Toronto committee, makes a startling report.

ADVERTISING LIQUOR is collecting sales. A decision of much interest to local liquor committees was handed out by Judge Wm. Reade at the end of last week, upholding the conviction of the Herlin Lion Brewery, for selling liquor in Galt, a local option town, by newspaper advertising.

IT IS HIGH TIME the municipal authorities provided doors on the local lock-up in the town hall which will keep obnoxious prisoners more securely. The old doors constructed a quarter century ago are obsolete.

THE ELECTIONS will be well supplied with ballots at the coming municipal election. There will likely be ballots for the Mayor and Council, for the members of the School Board, the Local Option appeal, and a ballot for a re-vote on the Hydro-Electric money by-law.

THE GUELPH Mercury is just launching another Trip Contest, the destination of the winners on this occasion to be New York and Bermuda. Three years ago the Mercury conducted one of the most successful contests ever carried out by a Canadian newspaper.

The present contest will close on the 15th February next, and soon afterwards the Mercury will send one of its staff as manager, and his wife as shipper, in charge of the winners to New York and Bermuda.

In this contest, as in the last, each candidate will compete for the trip against other candidates in the same district only, and not against those of any other district. There are ten districts in all, three in the city of Guelph and seven in the surrounding districts, and there will be one winner from each district, making ten candidates in all who will go on the trip.

This nomination forms may be clipped from the Mercury, the names of the lady candidate written on it by any responsible citizen, who will sign his name and get a counter signature On being mailed to the Mercury office, Guelph, directions and supplies will at once be sent to the candidate named, so that no time may be lost by her and her friends in getting in the contest. The result of the Mercury's last contest was watched with widespread interest, but the promise is that the interest now will be even greater.
