EDITORIAL NOTES

It would be well for those interested in subdivisions of land to remember that the new Municipal Act, which came into force on the 1st inst., contains the following important clause: "No municipal council or ward or land shall lay out any street less than 66 feet in width or, except in the case of a city or town, more than 100 feet in width."

A NEW DEVELOPMENT in Canadian finance, that is likely to dispel some of the pessimism that exists in certain circles, is the arrangement to issue term loans from Montreal to more of the crops this fall. Several Canadian banking institutions that have been prominent in handling the crop movement have secured from their English connections 90-day loans, the time of which may be extended if necessary.

THE HIGH COST of living has ceased to trend upward. On the other hand it shows no signs at present of sagging downwards. In the Department of Labor the number employed to produce the goods for the consumption of living has remained between 130 and 137. This means that people pay 37 per cent. more for living now than they did ten years ago. The Department does not at present anticipate any decrease in the high cost of living.

AFTER passing through the hands of the Finance Committee of the Workingmen, the provisions in the new Tariff Bill regarding importations of wheat, flour and bran were adopted by the Senate but radically changed from the House which was introduced by its originator. None of the three or four from Canada to the United States free of duty, as long as Canada's tariff wall on the said commodities is maintained. A reduced duty must be paid. On the other hand, the tariff on wheat imported from the United States is now 10 cents per bushel, which is the same as in the United States markets to these respects.
