The one powder was next brought into play, but the Sultan refused to give up one of the eight inch guns, which he had been invited to fire.

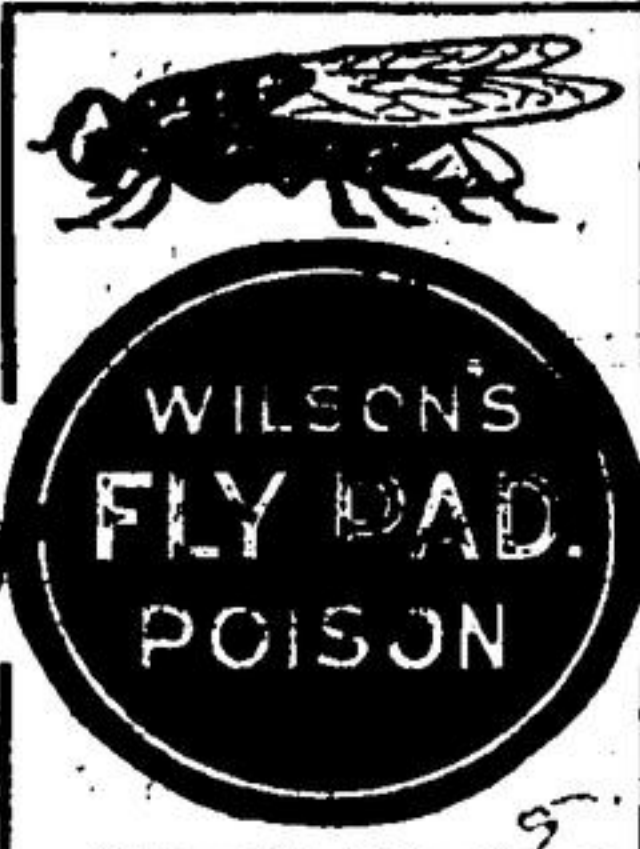
General Bates made his headquarters in the tower of the castle, and the Sultan and his staff came on several occasions to discuss the treaty.

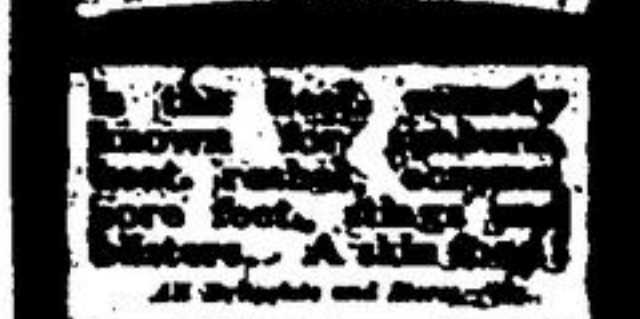

RENEWING THE FORESTS

Not much more than a century ago Ontario was almost unbrokenly forested. Now the southern portion which we call "Older Ontario" is all but denuded of woodlands.

Reforesting operations in Ontario had their beginning in the establishment of the Ontario Agricultural College in 1904. Here the agricultural student was trained in tree-planting and care of woodlands, and nurseries were established to produce young forest trees.

At present the forest nursery contains about 800,000 seedlings in seed-beds and 600,000 plants in the nursery lines.

Waste land to the extent of 100 acres has now been replanted with white pine, red pine, Scotch pine, white spruce, larch, poplar, and balsam poplar.

At present the varieties in the seed beds at the station are chiefly white pine, red pine, Scotch pine, white spruce, larch and hemlock.

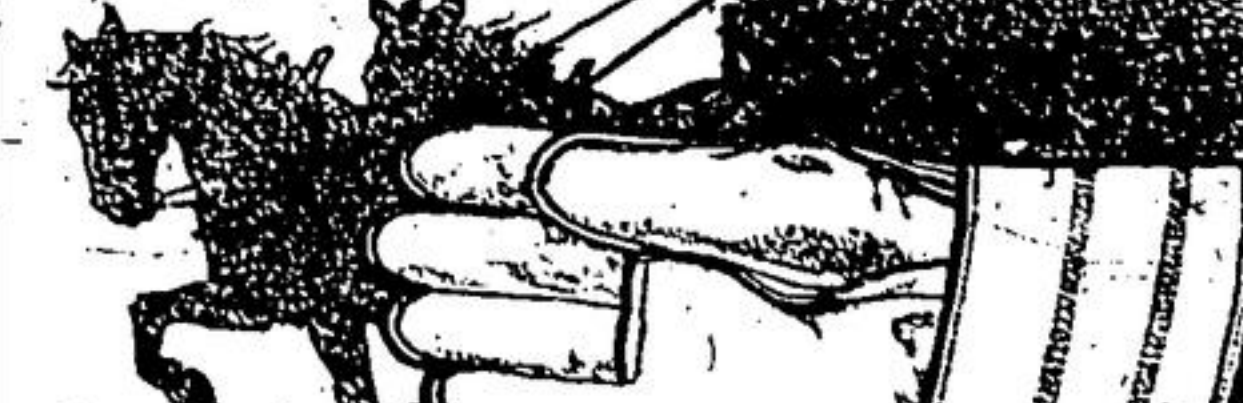

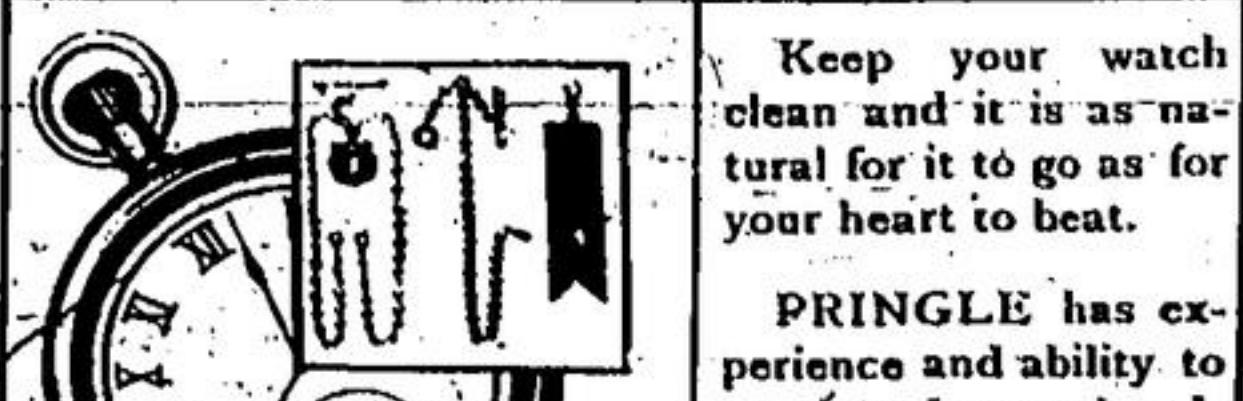
