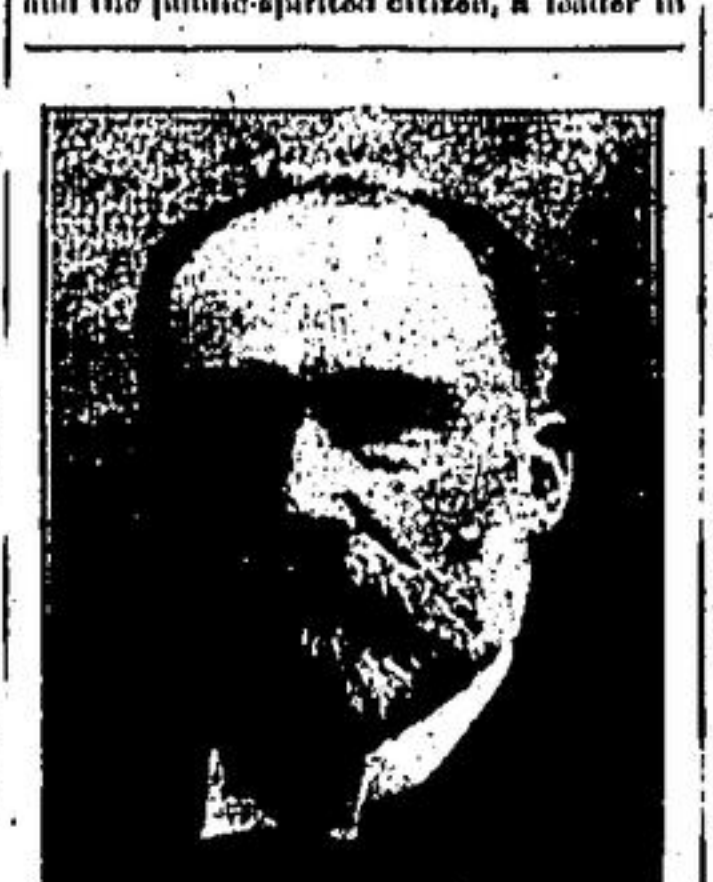


DEATHS

THE DEATH OF SIR GEORGE ROSS
This Great Canadian Statesman Passed Away on Saturday Morning
SIMPLE FUNERAL SERVICE ON TUESDAY
Death came to Sir George W. Ross early Saturday morning at the General Hospital, Toronto. This ends almost two months of illness and many years of suffering. With Sir George Ross has passed out the patriot, the politician, the statesman, and the public-spirited citizen, a leader in public thought, and a distinguished Canadian. Death, came in kindest guise heaving the end of a life which has already been a life of physical suffering. Along with a man and a house surgeon, Mr. Greer, the statesman passed away. The end was unexpected. Lady Ross and the other members of the family arrived just a moment after the spirit had fled.

Once a schoolmaster in the county of Middlesex where, in 1841, he was born, once a newspaper editor, a school inspector, a third young member of the Legislature, Minister of Education, Private Minister of this Province, leader of the Opposition, and finally a Senator at Ottawa—Sir George Ross's career unfolded a very wide experience. Infirmities of the body, through rheumatism, seemed never to affect the vigor of his mind. Almost to the end his mind was clear, the same acute thinking that had played so great a part in the affairs of his day.

The fatal illness had its beginning in an acute attack of influenza on Jan. 19th. The effort he made on that occasion left him in a state of exhaustion. On the way home he was exposed to a draft and caught a serious chill. For some days it seemed as if the great statesman was merely suffering from a simple cold, but by Jan. 24th it became apparent that he was seriously ill and was brought to Toronto General Hospital.
