Contests to Develop Skill in Treating Accidents. A new kind of contest of skill that has its roots upon the tournaments, its compelling teams, its cups and its champions and even perhaps its bitter rivalries and partisan loyalty has swept over the coast during the past few years. Though up to the present it is practically unknown in large parts of the country.

At a recent New Mexico contest, for instance, each team was told to proceed on the assumption that a fall of rock in a mine had broken the leg of a miner and had nearly killed the patient. The subject represented the injured miner, and each team gave the proper first aid for a fractured thigh, improved a splint and carried the man to safety through the low passageway over the fallen rock, represented by some loose logs, and with strings to mark the walls and roof of the passageway.—Saturday Evening Post.

ANTARCTIC FORESTS.

The World South Pole Once Burned Under a Tropical Sun. Probably the most interesting of the most recent expeditions to Antarctica, the one planned by the National History Museum at South Kensington, are the five pieces of coral found by Captain Scott's party in latitude 85 degrees. In the middle of the frozen plateau that stretches from King Edward's Land way beyond the South Pole. This coral was found by Commander Evans among the little islands of fossils which Captain Scott and his three companions dragged through the Antarctic ice. The coral was found on that memorable return journey which cost them their lives. The few tiny fragments, under the light of science, tell a wonderful story. If it is true, as these specimens strongly indicate, that there is coral in the South Pole, it follows that at some remote period there must have been forests growing in this frozen, ice covered land. Pined up in the little bits of coral is the hint of a tropical sun which once shone over the hills and fertile valleys of King Edward's Land, now a desolate ice waste.—London, Philadelphia Ledger.
