ASSESSMENT INCREASED \$88,904
An Excellent Prepared Roll Submitted to Council by Assessor Harvey
POPULATION NOW DECREASED 85
Assessor Harvey presented the Assessment Roll for 1914 to the Council at the meeting on Monday evening. It is a very carefully prepared and comprehensive roll. Neat and clean and complete in all respects. Rarely, if ever before, has a roll been presented to the Council in so satisfactory a form.
When the Assessor commenced his duties the mandate of the Council was given him to "increase the assessment by twenty per cent." This he has accomplished in a very equitable manner. The 20 per cent. increase has practically been accomplished. If the Council is so careful to keep down the rate as Assessor Harvey has been to meet their desire for an increased assessment there will be no appreciable increase in the tax burden resulting from the higher assessment.
The Assessment for 1914 is \$548,932. The increase, \$87,904.
The assessment is made up as follows:
Real property \$171,203; Millage \$38,431; Local assessment \$348,297; taxable income \$322.
Number of acres assessed 4301.
The census of the population shows a decrease of 85. This is accounted for in several ways. The continued influx of foreigners to living on Canadian citizens. Last year the Toronto Southern Railway and the Hydro-Electric transmission line were under construction and a considerable number in the construction gangs were residents here.
It will be interesting to note that \$75,000 worth of municipal, government and ecclesiastical property in Acton is exempt from taxation, as follows:

The assessment and other statistics of the two polling subdivisions of the town are remarkably similar in amounts, the population and the number of dogs being the only two items which are markedly dissimilar.
In No. 1 there are 211 acres; in No. 2 616.
The assessment in No. 1 aggregates \$254,497 and in No. 2, \$294,435. The business assessment \$22,957 and \$22,250.
The school population is as follows:
Scholars from 8 to 21, 418; from 3 to 16, 232; from 14 to 21, 217.
The number of persons between 21 and 60 is 127.
There have been 70 dogs, male and female, assessed. The balance were all out of town or secreted when the Assessor made his round.
Acton last year had 37 births and 12 deaths.
