### EDITORIAL NOTES

The Conservatives of the County have talked matters over and it is the consensus of opinion to stick to De. A. W. Nixon, the present member. It is not thought a wise time to make a change so the doctor will again carry their standard—Oakville Star. The Conservative convention will be held in Milton on Friday, when the candidate will probably be chosen.

Government statistics show that immigration to Canada totalled 2,043,164 since 1897 or during the last 17 years. During the past five years the growth has been increased steadily from 165,000 in 1908-9, to 422,432 in 1912-13. The last financial year 1907-08 started lumbering and a falling away is likely to occur this year at least, according to estimates of the Immigration Department.

The Receiver of Canada, which dropped to nearly nothing dollars during the past fiscal year, is beginning the new fiscal year with another tumble. The total revenue for April was \$9,610,000, as compared with \$12,142,483 of April last year. The decrease is \$2,209,487, or nearly 19 per cent. The principal falling off is, of course, in customs returns, which decreased by some two millions, reflecting a corresponding restriction of imports.

The operation of the Pulse Advertising Bill, as illustrated in the House by the Minister, A. G. L. Smith, shows that the merchant who advertises his goods as "new" when they are not will be liable to a fine of \$200 or six months in jail, because that is a misrepresentation of fact, but his neighbor, who says his goods are the best in town, will not be liable, because that is merely a matter of opinion.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS for Miller's government buildings have been received from Ottawa by Mr. Stewart, postmaster. They are for a postoffice only, and though he expects to be a fine one, it does not satisfy the people of Milton, who want a customs house. Certain officials understand some things are to explain to the Government why they should not do it. It is to be presumed that they did so and that their efforts have failed. What is the explanation?—Champion.

THE CANADIAN TRADE COMMISSIONERS in Germany have issued the price of Canadian wheat in that country as follows: "In wheat, during 1913, Canada improved her position by 50,000 tons over 1912, and by no less than 2,800,000 tons over 1911. Although it was freely stated last year that Canada would not be able to maintain her imports with normal crops in Russia, it is obvious that these anticipations have been fulfilled in the event, the fact being that the German wheat trade is now so important with the vast continental land wheat for their purposes that they are attempting to buy largely under any circumstances, and with Germany's requirements already rising every year, it is believed that purchases of Canadian wheat will continue on a progressive scale."

His Excellency Prince Alexander of York, brother of Queen Mary, will become Governor General of Canada in October. He was born in Kensington Palace forty years ago, and has had a distinguished military career. His wife was Her Royal Highness the Duchess of Albany, grand-daughter of Queen Victoria, and she is one of the prettiest members of the British royal family. If the Prince of York proves to be as good a Governor General as he was a soldier in South Africa, he will equal the record of the Duke of Connaught, which is one of the very best in the history of the Dominion.

THE BILL making tipping and the taking of tips illegal officially passed the Senate committee of the whole yesterday without opposition. The bill was introduced some time ago by Senator Davies, western senator, and at first excited much ridicule. Then suddenly a widespread demand for the passing of the bill sprang up with the result that the bill has now been pushed through the committee, which means that it will pass the Senate and be sent to the house committee for concurrence. The bill makes it an offence punishable by a fine of \$100 to give or take a tip and makes the employer equally guilty.

English-speaking people have not yet quite reached the standard laid down by the late President Cleveland in viewing a "public office as a trust." But we are at last more advanced than our predecessors of a few generations back. The London Chronicle informs us that the wife of a one-time British Cabinet Minister, having stood godmother to a friend's infant son, expressed regret that her husband had nothing of importance left at his disposal at the time, but that if they liked he would put his godson on the pension list—a superannuated person.

**NORTHWEST CROP CONDITIONS**  
Little, if any, increase in the average crop yields.

**THIS CROP IS ALL SOLD**  
Winnipeg, May 18.—Following is a summary of conditions from 135 points in the West reported by the Free Press:

The condition of the ground at sowing was almost universally poor.

The report indicates that there is little, if any, increase in the acreage. If there is any increase, it will not exceed five per cent.

The report indicates that the acreage is acreage in oats and barley will be large, but there is a material increase in the acreage of flax from 35 to possibly 40 per cent.

The general condition of the crop is very satisfactory, though it is rather later than could be desired.

Reports indicate that the crop of 1913 has been almost completely sold out, the bidding in the farmers' hands, being exceptionally light.

### MORRIS SAXE IS BURNED OUT BIG DEMONSTRATION ON MONDAY AGAIN

Nobis' Flour and Feed Store and Oddfellows' Hall also Heavy Losses

#### THE WORK OF AN INCENDIARY

A few minutes before two on Monday morning the fire bell rang out its thunderous alarm. Citizens saw in a moment that a fierce fire was raging somewhere near the heart of the town. Investigation soon proved that the rough stone and dwelling of Morris Saxe, Jewish Merchant, at the corner of Main and Willow Streets—the former block—was on fire.
