Wheat 22,429,500 bush. Oats 23,888,304 " Barley 15,129,325 " Corn 7,631,374 " Peas 705,825 " Beans 628,623 " Potatoes 4,721,840 " Onions 271,529 " Meat 26,508,766 lbs. Eggs 121,119,816 doz. Butter and Lard 20,423,323 lbs. Cheese 21,748,323 lbs. The above mentioned sources of supply of staple foods are now in the main, cut off as a result of the war.
