CITIZENS ARE REQUESTED TO
COMPLY WITH THE PUBLIC
HEALTH ACT

NOTICE is hereby given that all residents of
Acton are required to clean out their houses, wash
drains, yards, pig pens, water closets, and remove
therefrom all dirt, muck and other
matter which may be found therein, and to have the same
completely cleaned out by April 20, 1917, or
on which day the Sanitary Inspector
will commence his inspection of the Public
Buildings. It is noted that the section of the Public
Buildings between the 1st May and the 1st of June
is to be kept clear of all dirt, mud, trash, etc., 10 feet from any
dwelling house, and 20 feet from any stable, garage, or
other building. Water must be kept clear from any standing
water and regular cleaning will be strictly
enforced. All persons are sharply required to have
their premises constantly clean and thoroughly
disinfected.
