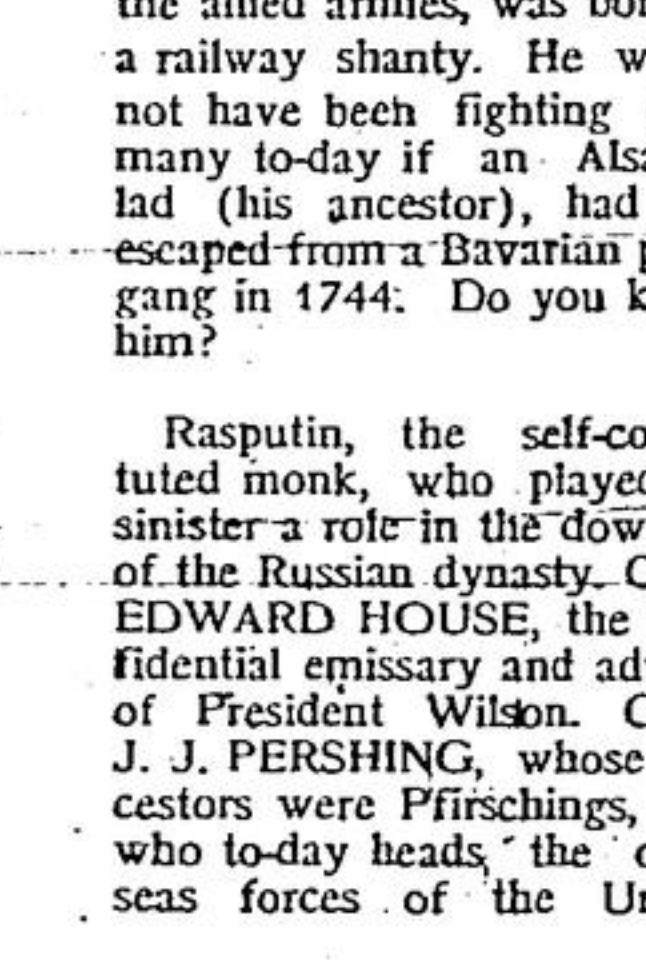

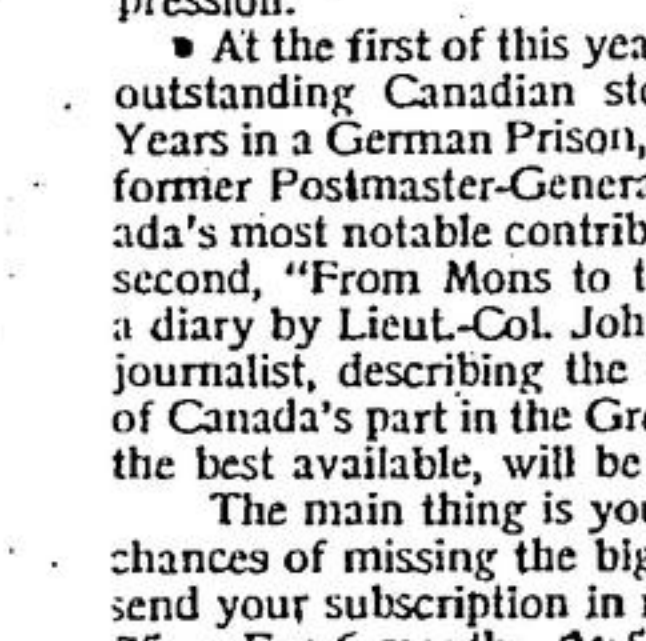


THE THIRD, a general in the allied armies, was born in a railway shanty... He acted as its secret but unofficial agent after war had been declared...
