Thousands of Women and Children Have Already Been Saved by the Contributions

MUCH HELP IS NEEDED

The goal of the oppressed people of Armenia is beyond description. A writer who has been in that country and knows conditions says: "Let us not forget for a moment that Armenia is indeed 'bread-Crisisland.' They are not persecuted even 'till death you, and worse than death, like little refugees, runabout, daily, in search of food and shelter."

Rev. H. T. Hartlett, Manager of the Art Department of the Standard Book and Publishing House, Toronto, had written to his constituents, friends and the public concerning the condition of the country and the misery of the people as they actually were.
