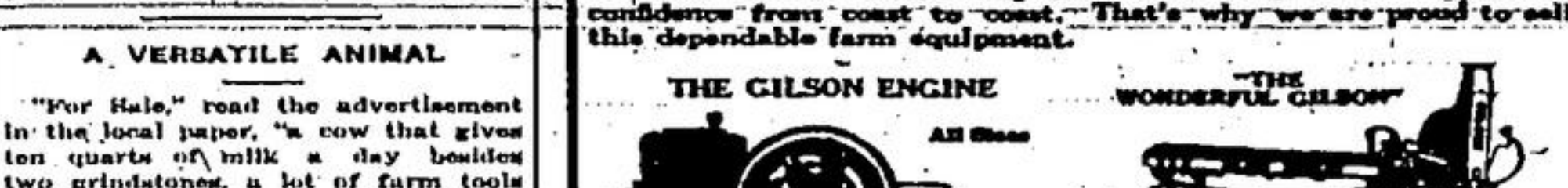
RECORD OF 1920 MEAN TEMPERATURES VICTORIA, B. C.
