When Steve, who lived far up in Canada, went to visit his uncle in a southern town, he found a great deal to interest him...

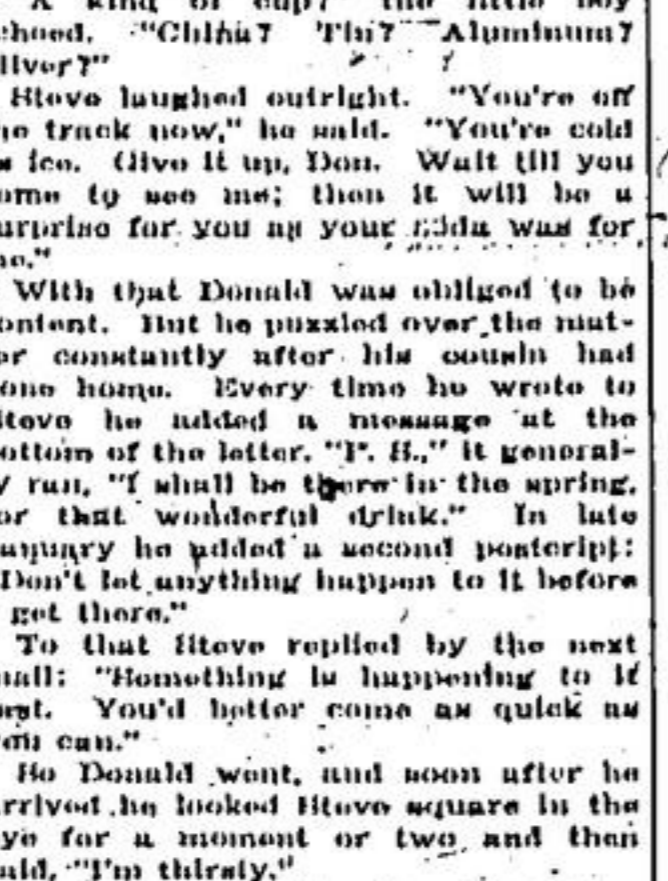

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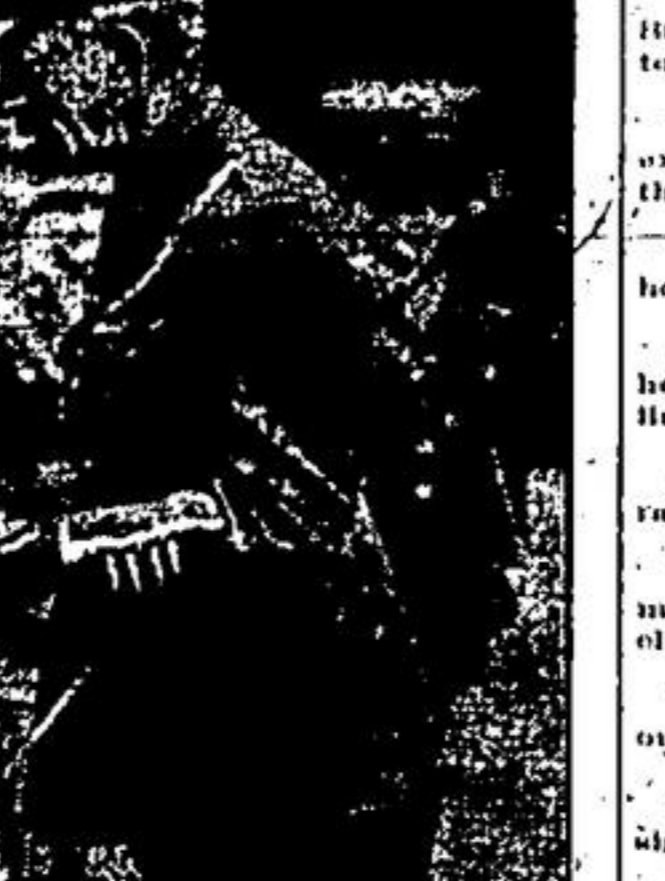
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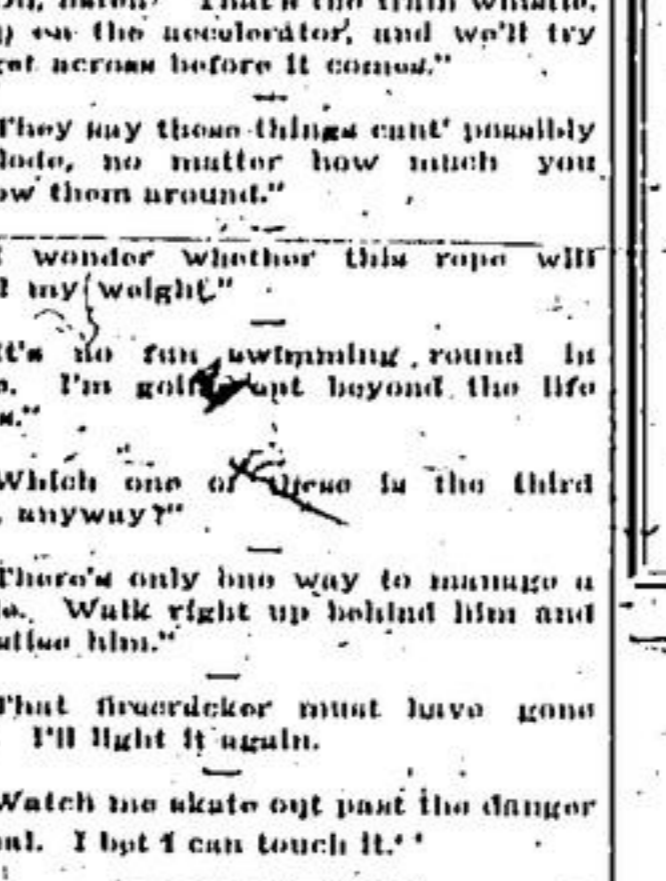
