JAMES TEACHING AT ANTIOPHIS

Acts 11: 15-16; 12: 25.

Golden Text—"For a whole year they were gathered together with the church and taught much people" (Acts 11: 26).

Lesson Comments.

Verse 10.—The Antioch church was established between A. D. 40 and 44. After the martyrdom of Stephen the disciples had to flee in all directions to escape the fury of the Jews of the land north of Palestine in the Mediterranean. They preached to Jews themselves, and found it hard to convince of a religion different from Gentiles. Cyprus is an island in the eastern end of the Mediterranean.

Verse 20.—There were two Antioch churches. One was in Syria, the other in Asia Minor. This one is in Syria. Cyrene was the capital of the province on the north coast of Africa west of Egypt. Some have thought the Greeks here were Greek Jews, but it is not probable. They were doubtless Gentiles.

Verse 21.—The New Testament acknowledges sincere conversion to Christ by the Gentiles. The Lord's message about through the preaching of men.

Verse 22.—The report concerning Gentile conversion reached Jerusalem, for which there was no compensation, for that is violence has been done to the Jewish ceremonial law.

Verse 23.—There was some danger of conflict between Jew and Gentile, but the Christians had sent to the Jewish leaders to let them know that in order to settle in Quebec Province.
