Golden Text—"For I determined not to know anything from you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified" (1 Cor. 2:2).

Verse 6—"This was a vigorous and energetic man, who thought that he was subverting their cherished tradition, when, in fact, he was preaching the true faith..."

Verse 7—"Fortunately, there was a Gentile in the city a year and a half man of means, and favorably impressed by Paul. In the home of this man Paul continued his work."

Verse 8—"The common people often heard the gospel gladly, but it was seldom that men of high positions in the synagogue obeyed. It was therefore greatly to the credit of Crispus that he became a follower of Christ."
