PAUL BEFORE THE ROMAN GOVERNOR—Acts 23: 25-24: 27.

Golden Text—"Herod I plan exasperate myself to have a conclusion void of offence toward God and men always."—Acts 23: 14.

Lesson Comments

Verse 13.—After Paul addressed on the temple steps he had to flee from Jerusalem to Caesarea, where Governor Felix of Judea took him in charge.

Felix was a good man, above all years.

He was unrighteous and cruel.

Verse 14.—Paul had been away from Jerusalem five days and imprisoned one. He made up his mind to speak up much more freely in the remaining six.

Verse 15.—Paul had the right to argue and dispute, but had not done so.

Verse 16.—Paul demands real proof and legal evidence.

Verse 17.—"The Way" was a term that came into general use (Acts 9: 2; 19: 9, 23; 22: 4; 2 Pet. 2: 2).

Verse 18.—Paul said that he believed everything that was true which all the rest of those believed. Which audience believed in the resurrection; no did Paul.

Verse 19.—The word "offense" here denotes injury or harm. A consciousness of offense must be traded in the truth and constantly active.

Verse 20.—Paul had collected money to help the poor he had founded in Macedonia and Achaea for the relief of the brethren in Jerusalem.

Verse 21.—While in the temple he had scrupulously conformed to the law.

Verse 22.—It was a principle of the Roman law that no prisoner should be judged without his accusers facing him.

Verse 23.—Paul challenges the production of evidence.
