Acton Fall Fair

Interesting Meeting and Good Reports at the Annual Review of Business on Monday

\$50.00 OF RAIN INSURANCE ON ACCOUNT OF 1921 FAIR

The large attendance of members at the annual meeting of Acton Fall Fair on Monday afternoon, in the Council Chamber, manifested a very gratifying interest in the popular fair.

The auditor's report for the year 1921 shows the following receipts and expenditures:

Receipts

Balance from 1920 season \$ 105.00

Members' tickets, donations, grants, fees, government grant, gate receipts, and other receipts 1,413.36

Deficit 20.29

Payments

Prize money and special prizes 1,007.10

Paint, printing, judges, secretary, gate keepers and expenses 631.41

\$1,638.54

The financial surplus of the fair amounting to \$105.00, was placed in bank to credit of the society's \$527.71.

The secretary reported that since the first of the year, the sum of \$91.50 had been received from the Municipal Government for rain insurance, the rain having interfered with the attendance at the fair.

There were 1,284 entries at the fair of 1921.
