Verse 12.—This was not a time to be discouraged. It was a time to be encouraged.

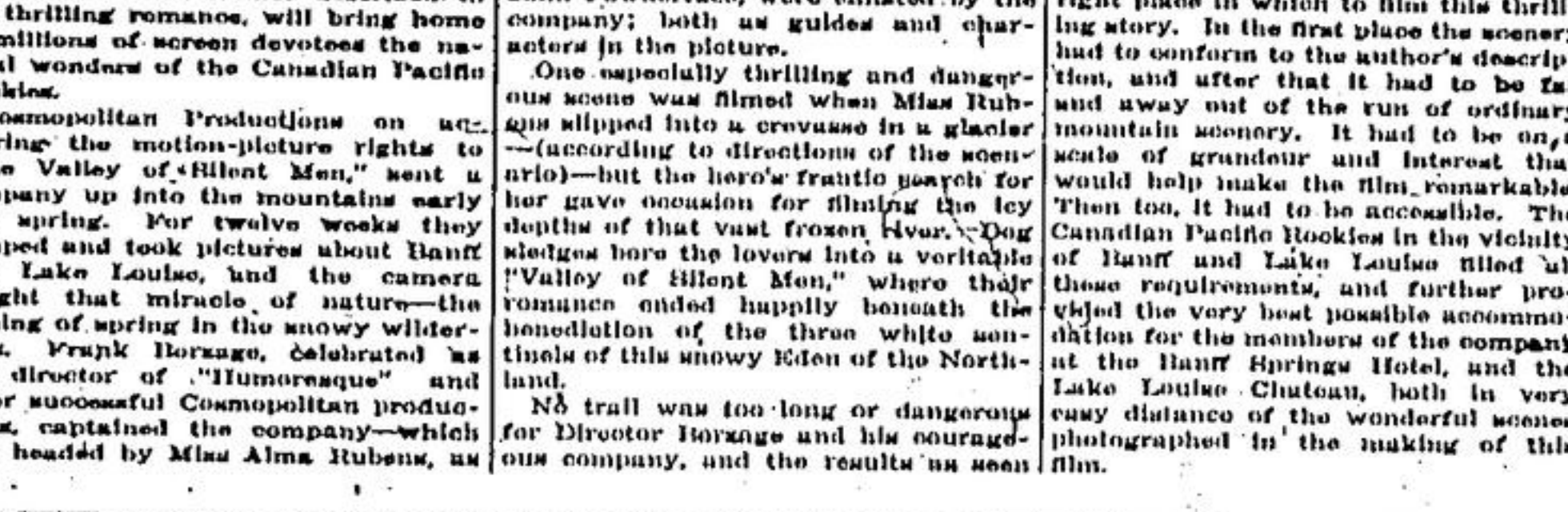
THE MOVIES AND THE ROCKIES
