NEW IMMIGRATION POLICIES

Policies which have been adopted for the selection, transportation, and colonization of British settlers have been outlined by the Hon. Mr. Hobb, Minister of Immigration and Colonization.

The agreement which has just been concluded with the Imperial Government provides for financial assistance to three types of British settlers, namely: children, nominated persons, and household workers.

Persons may be nominated for assistance under the nominated passage scheme by British citizens who are resident in Canada, by the Dominion Government or any of its agents, or by a provincial government in Canada or its agents.

Of particular importance is the fact that under the new arrangements persons in Canada, who are not British subjects, need not be personally acquainted with the nominee.

In addition to this agreement with the Imperial Government for selection and assistance in immigration, Mr. Hobb, who is providing for their reception and settlement in Canada, has announced that he will be assisted in his work by the Dominion Government.

The new branch is already engaged in a survey of farm employment opportunities, and will assist in providing farm employment and also household workers for service on the farms.
