SAVING SNOW-BOUND DEER FROM STARVATION



How They Brought the Deer In Above—Too Exhausted to Escape Below—Quite Happy After Rescue

When winter comes and with it the deepest snows of the season the deer in the north country often have no opportunity to perform their annual acts towards the animals that roam the woods.

That was the case when these photographs were taken near St. John's, a pleasant little summer and winter resort that lies among the Laurentian hills on the Canadian Pacific Railway north of Montreal.

The deer too exhausted to make any serious attempt to escape, gently but firmly their feet were tied with strips of packing to prevent injury through struggling.

They were laid on the logs and hauled back to the hotel where their husbands-to-be lay in wait, and a sled to sled in quite a moderate temperature.

It became a matter of some importance to get the deer to the hotel in a moderate temperature, not in the sun and do not allow them to freeze.

Sun is injurious to wool; freezing causes shrinkage.
