THE SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

FOR SUNDAY, MAY 4, 1924

THE FALL OF THE NORTHERN KINGDOMS—2 Kings 17: 1-23

John Text—Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments and my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers and which I send to you by my servants the prophets—2 Kings 17: 13.

The Text Explained Verse 9.—High Places.—Considered holy and used as places of worship because of features of nature which inspired reverence, such as springs, towers, trees, mountains. High places were not peculiar to the Hebrews, or even the Semitic people.

Verse 10.—Asherah.—Mural of Asherah, wooden pole or post of symbolic significance, the goddess Asherah probably symbolized the goddess Asherah. One of the heathen altars was decorated by the Hebrews in their worship.

Verse 12.—Evil ways.—The language recalls the ceremonial and the ritual of the Canaanites, the Phoenicians, and the Syrians. The altar for which Israel is condemned are (a) the building of high places, pillars, and Asherah; (b) idolatry; (c) the worship of Baal; (d) the worship of the sun, moon, and stars.

Lesson Theme.—The Peculiar Power of Idolatry.—Idolatry is a constant and continued conflict with God. It was strange also that it should be a constant fall back to their former estate.

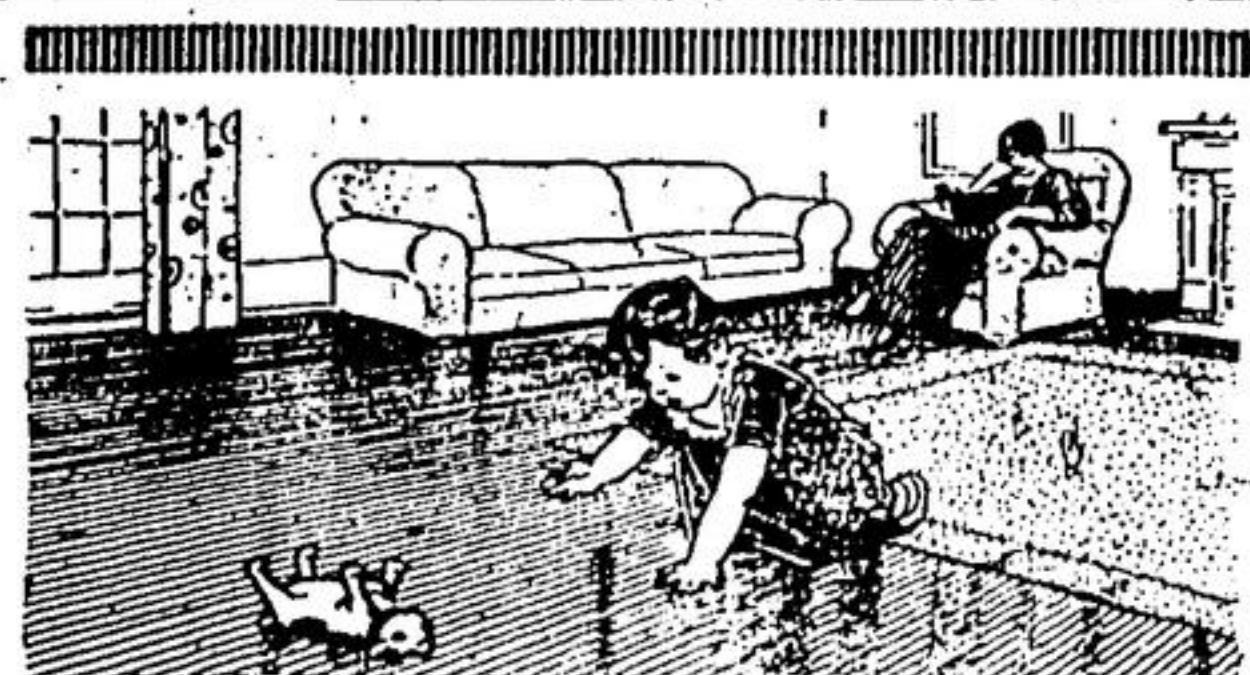
