Haltom Farmer Killed in Auto Accident

Robert Cleaves, of Hornby, Killed When Car Goes Over Embankment

A fatal automobile accident occurred at Drummond at 6 o'clock Sunday evening, in which Robert Cleaves, farmer of Hornby, lost his life. Mr. Cleaves was driving a touring car, accompanied by his wife and children. Mrs. Walter Thompson and her two children, of Georgetown, while traveling north on the Howland road, turned out to allow an approaching car, which they thought might be a runaway, to pass. When the car passed and rolled down a 14-foot embankment. It was instantly killed. A passing car stopped and several men lifted the wrecked car up and released the other occupants, who were practically unharmed. The driver, Robert Cleaves, who was about 34 years of age, was well known and highly respected in the district. The body was taken to C. R. Turner's undertaking parlour at Milton.
