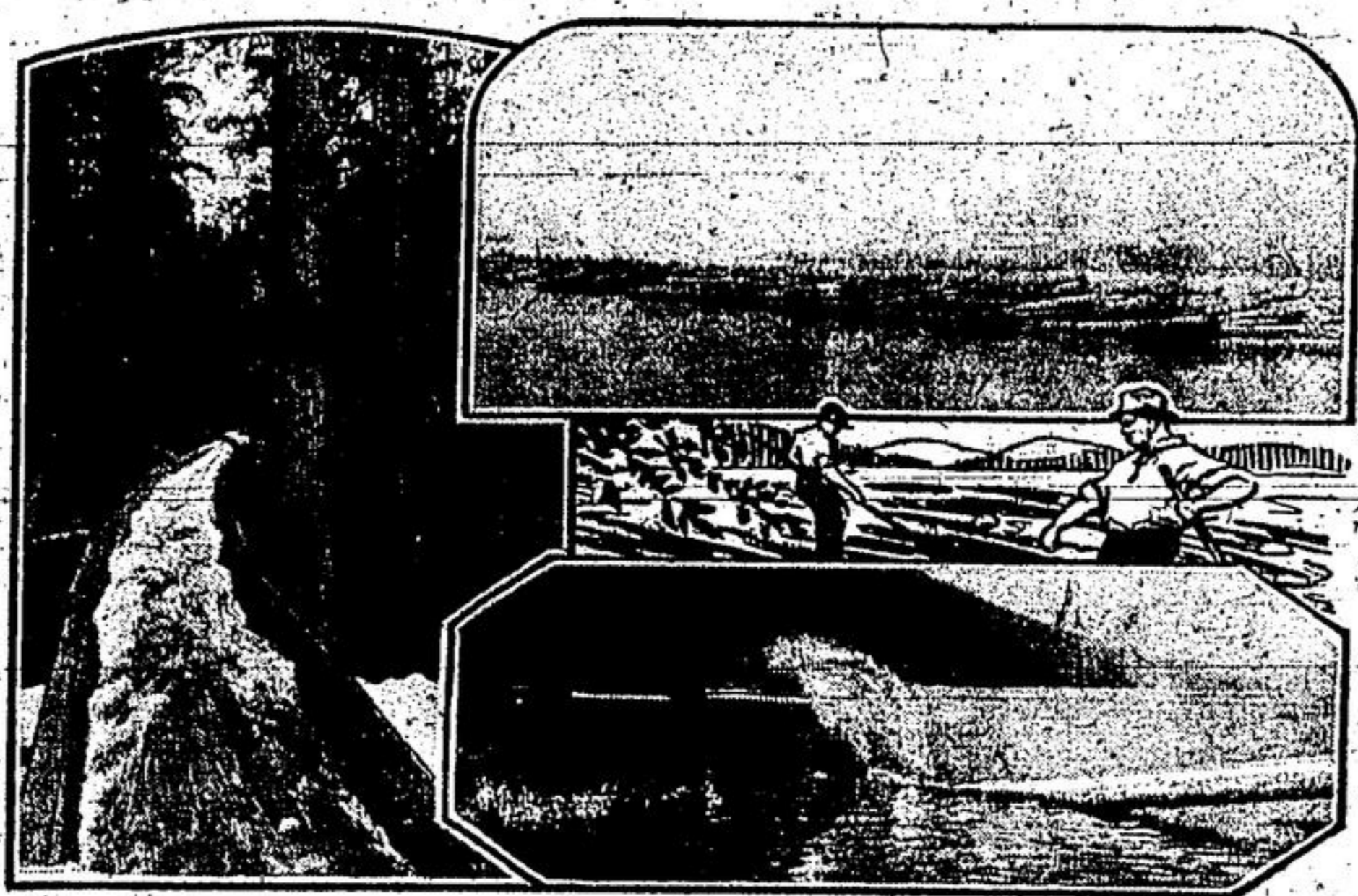

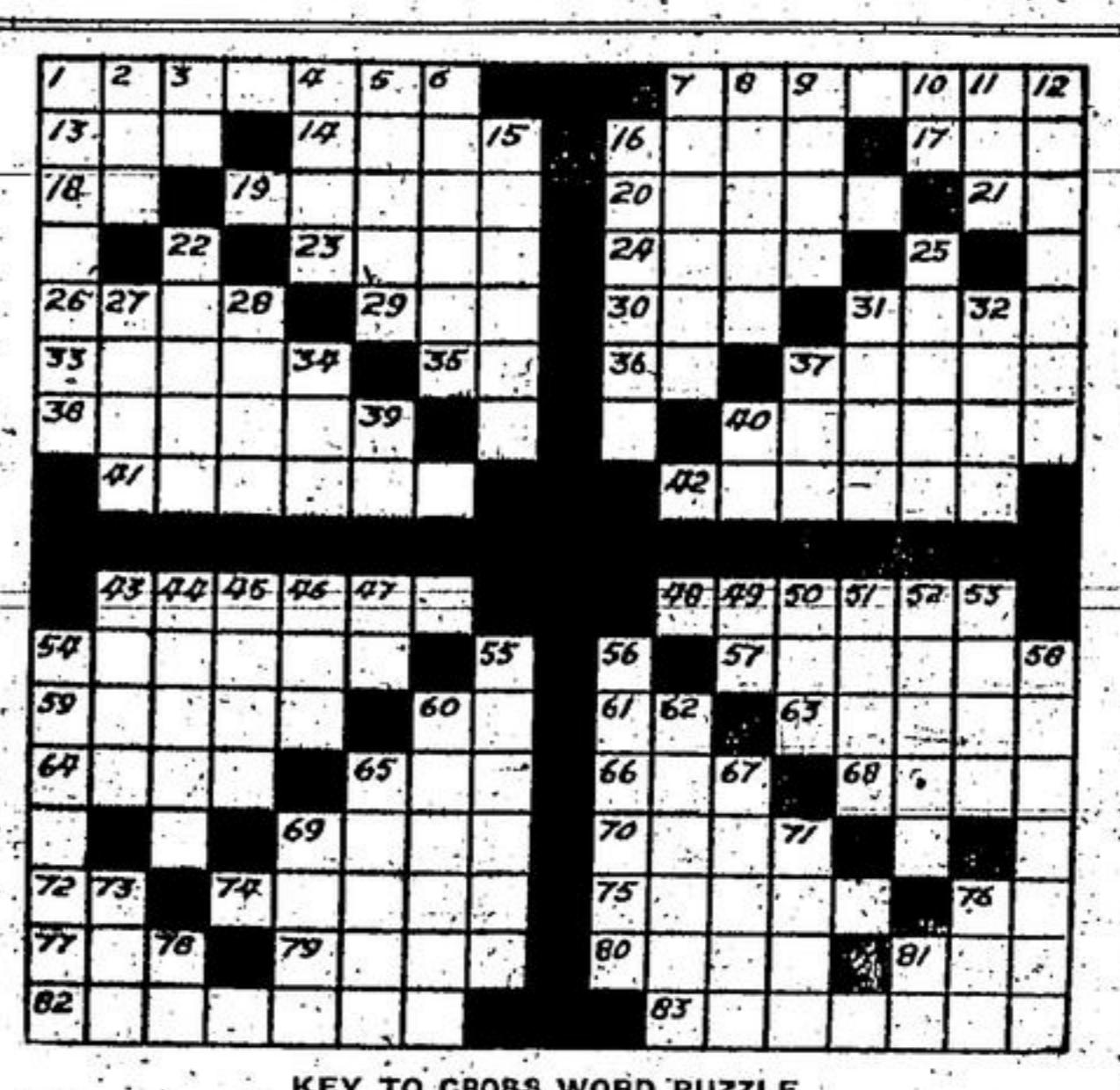
WILLIS'S IMPROMPTU VERSE

UNITED STATES WANTS REAL PROHIBITION

Michigan adopted prohibition by a majority of 68,000 and three years later defeated a beer and wine amendment by 297,000.
