GOD'S DEALINGS WITH NOAH
General Lesson Title.—Noah's Covenant With Noah.
Scripture Lesson.—Gen. 5: 28 to 9: 29
Golden Text.—I do set my bow in the clouds, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between Me and the earth.
—Gen. 9: 12.

The Text Explained
Noah and . . . his sons—All humanity. The covenant which follows is agreement between God and the human race.
10. God's loving thought extends to the entire animal kingdom. In this verse there is a suggestion of the thought which is given in the wonderful closing verse of the book of Jonah. Creation is the nature expressed by Coleridge in the Rhythms of the Ancient Mariner:
"He prayeth well, who loveth well
Both man and bird and beast.
"He prayeth best, who loveth best
All things both great and small;
For he that loveth another
His brother and his neighbor
His made and loveth all."

Lesson Themes
A World of Sin and Death. Here we have another picture of sin and its consequences, sin which turns away the face of the loving Father—sin which blights and destroys—which curses and slays. We see the human race given up to selfishness—"All flesh corrupt in its way upon the earth." The origin of sin is the nature, consequence. It is possible for a man even to-day to give himself up to complete selfishness—that is, to speak of goodness which was in his heart (for there is a light which lightens every man coming into the world) and to give himself up to it. It is a Man Who Walks With God. In a world of corruption, amid conditions that are vile, one man moves untouchably above the crowd. One man has the strength of character to rise triumphantly above his environment. The story of Noah is intended to teach the lesson that it is possible for one who keeps his eyes fixed on higher things to walk serene, unmastered by his surroundings. Bearing in mind that all Old Testament personalities are to be measured by the standards of the New Testament, we may say that this character personality faith, which lays hold on God with absolute confidence, and faithfulness, which continues on to truth to his own standards, no matter how difficult his situation may be.

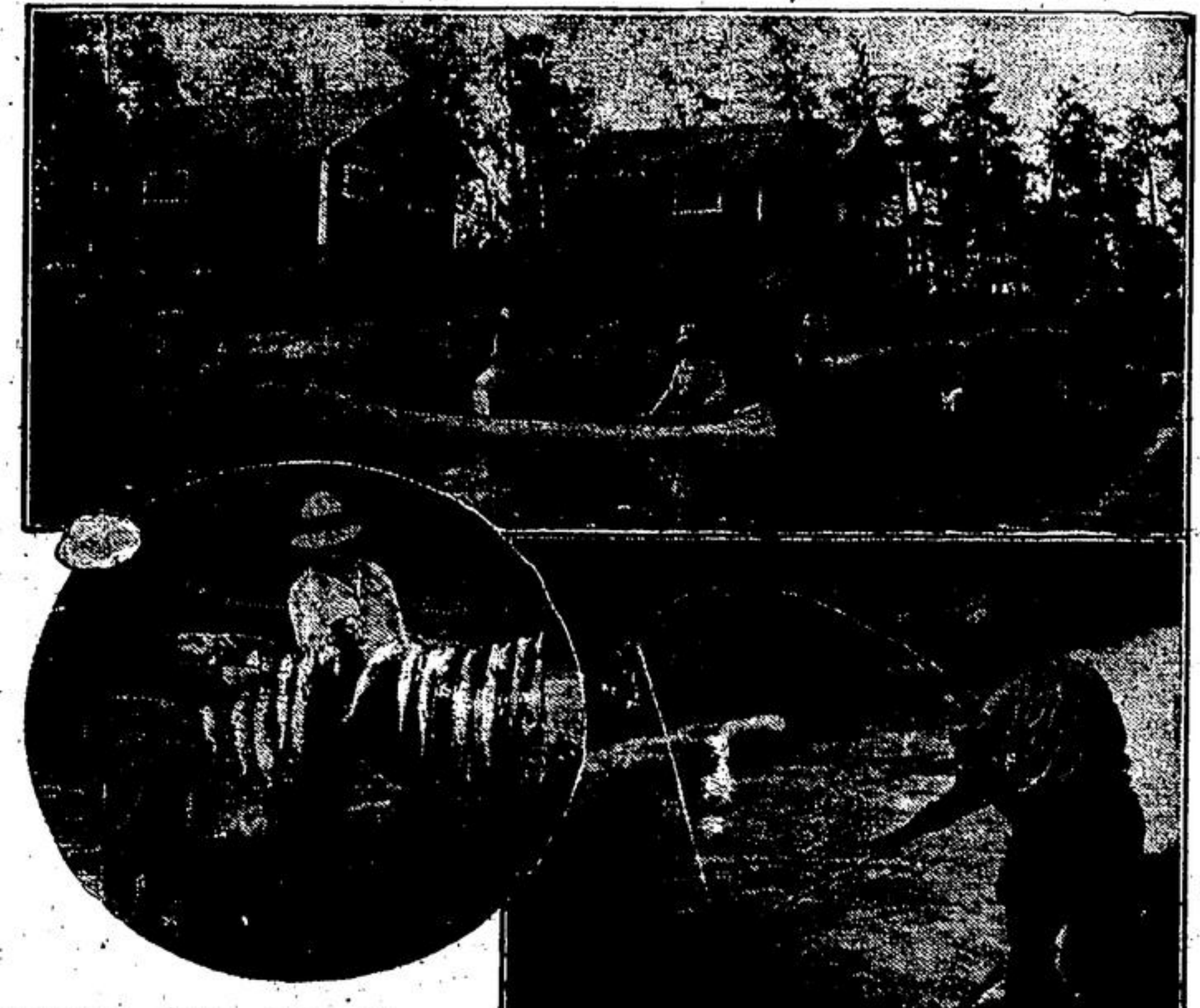
LOCATION OF ORCHARDS
The usual rainfall in a district has an important influence on the success of an apple orchard and should be well considered before setting out a plantation. Apple trees are exorbitant in their demands on soil moisture and unless cheap irrigation is available they require an annual rainfall of at least twenty to twenty-five inches. This is explained clearly in a new bulletin on the cultivation of the apple in Canada, issued by the Department of Agriculture and distributed by the Publications Branch, Department of Agriculture, Ottawa. THE PUBLIC HEALTH
CITIZENS ARE REQUESTED TO COMPLY WITH THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT
Notice is hereby given that all residents of Acton are required forthwith to clean their collars, drapes, yards, pig sty, water closets, outbuildings, and premises generally, and to be free from all dirt, manure, and other substances which may endanger the public health and to have the same completed by the sixth day of May next, on which day the Sanitary Inspector will commence a general inspection and further take notice that the section of the Health Act which prohibits the keeping of hogs between the 15th of May and the 15th of November, except in pens at least 70 feet from any dwelling house, and 50 feet from any street or lane, with proper kept clear from all standing water and regularly cleaned, will be strictly enforced. All citizens are earnestly requested to keep their premises constantly clean and thoroughly disinfected.
