NEW C. P. R. COLD STORAGE CARS



Under old conditions there was always a certain amount of risk in shipping fruit. The entry of dust or condensation, or the high temperature of the car, was frequently the cause of the fruit becoming spoiled during transit.

For many months officials of the Canadian Pacific Railway and the Dominion Express have been carrying on experimental work with a new type of ventilated express car to be used in the handling of soft fruits by express to prairie points, and they have recently completed a series of tests.

This device allows the air to be recirculated into the car through two apertures located at the ends of the car, the air entering through the front aperture in velocity and effectively distributed through the lower sections of the car.
