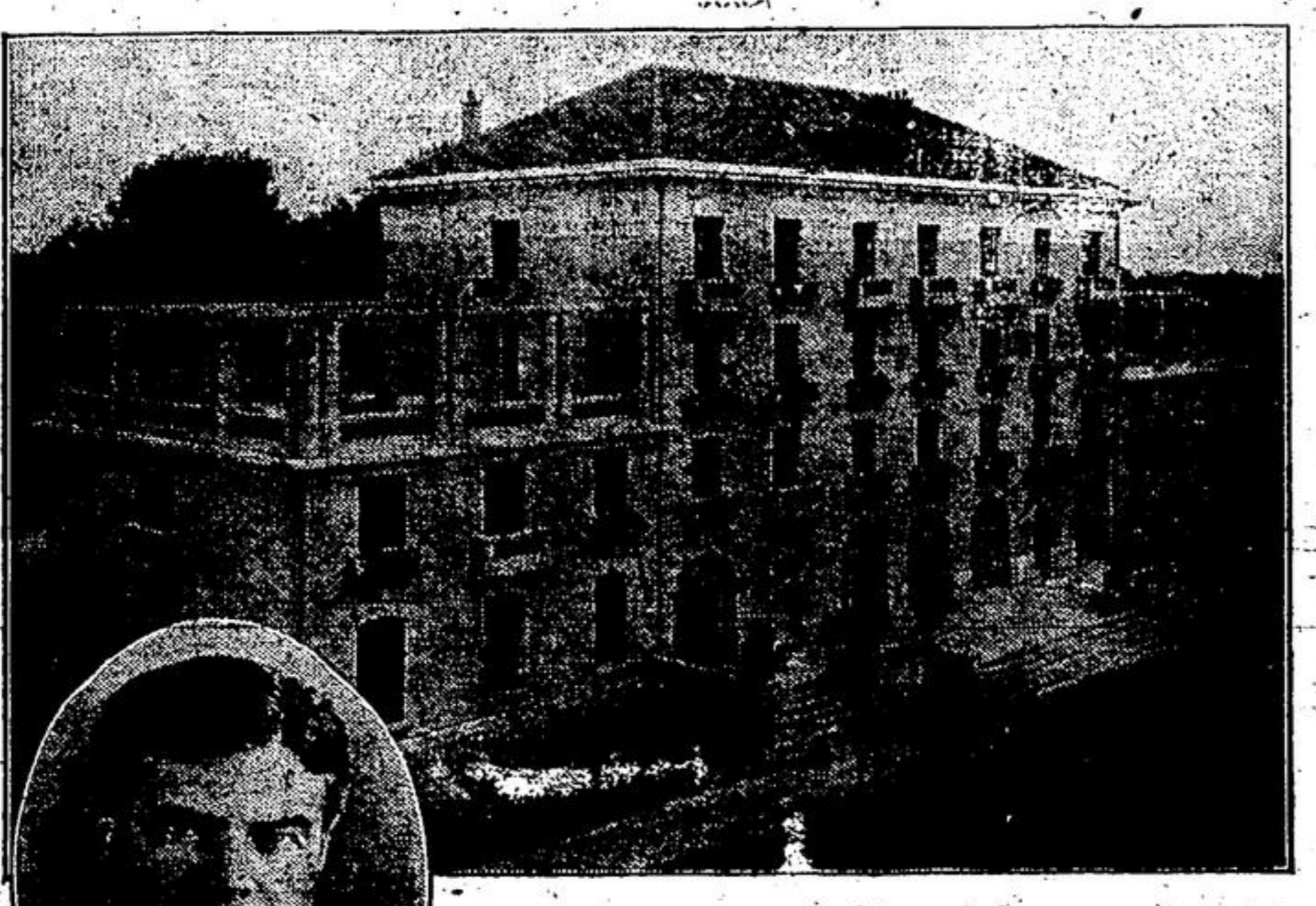

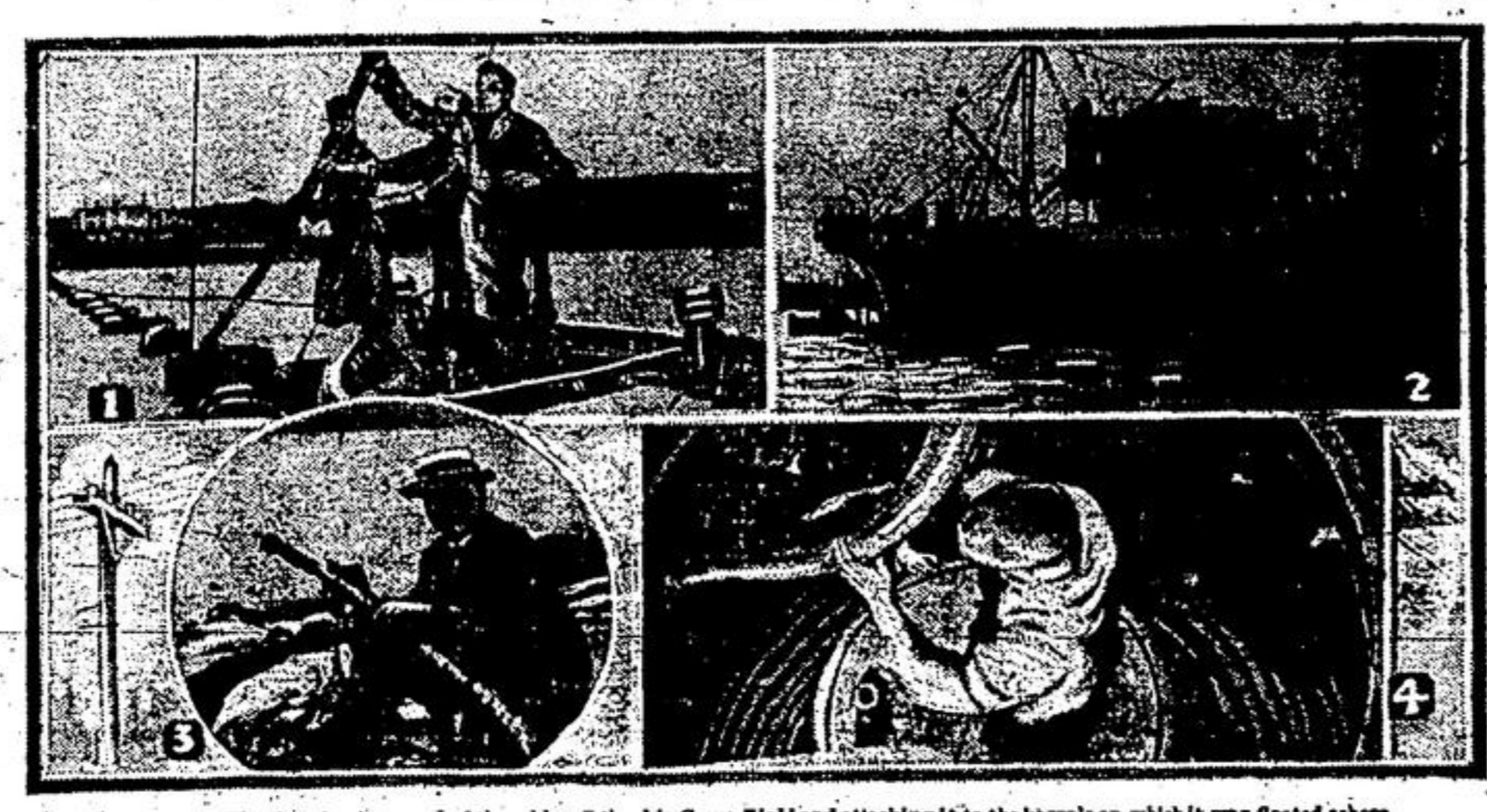
PRINCE OPENS CANADIAN STUDENT HOTEL IN PARIS
