**THE CLEANING AND GRAZING OF CLOVEE SEED**

The production of clover seed in northern Ontario is increasing every year, and most of the settlers are finding this an excellent cash crop with which to supplement their income obtained from the sale of live stock, and other farm products.

No matter how successful the farmer may be in the production of clover seed he cannot hope to obtain maximum returns unless this seed is properly cleaned and graded, so that it may be legally sold under the Seed Control Act. It is true that the seeds of some varieties that grow in red and white clover are of such size that they are somewhat difficult to remove by the sieves in an ordinary cleaning mill. In an attempt to obviate this difficulty a few special sieves for this work which will soon pay for themselves in efficiency of the work done.

Now that the farming mill, however, can be expected to do as good work in cleaning these small seeds as a properly equipped and operated power cleaner, in any seed where the production of clover seed is being featured as a business, the installing of one of these machines in a cooperative basis should prove a good investment.

A few days ago Mr. J. D. Kellie, of Kitchener, Ontario, where one of these machines is installed for custom cleaning, it had been found to do very excellent work in cleaning small seed.

At present it is necessary to send samples of the seed to the seed branch at Ottawa, for grading. When the grade is received the seed may be placed upon the market. It is believed that this will bring much better price than will the ungraded product as it comes from the threshing mill—Experimental Farm Note.
