Diphtheria Can Be Prevented

Diphtheria is caused by notion or toxin produced by the diphtheria germs the latter seeks to protect itself, and it ney. does so by producing diphtheria antitoxine or anti-poison, which counteracts or neutrilizes the toxin. If this occurs quickly enough and a sufficient quantity is produced the body wins and rest take place but something happens inside the human body which enables it, in

most cases, to prevent a second attack of the disease. Can protection similar to that conferred by one attack of the actual discase be gained without the danger of death and without fear of the suffering that comes with the disease? The answer is "yes."

Diphtheria can be prevented by the injection of diphtheria toxoid or toxinantitoxin. This method is known as diphtheria immunication. The injections | Kingsley Wood.




